COVIDSafe Plan

For the safety of our staff, visiting artists, and the community we ask all visitors to the venue to agree to the following:

- To follow instructions from staff and volunteers.

- BMEC reserves the right to refuse entry to any visitor who is visibly unwell.
- We recommend the use of the COVIDSAFE app.
- Ticket holders who are feeling unwell should not attend the venue. Please contact the Box Office via phone or email prior to the event. Tickets can be refunded if you are unwell with flu like symptoms.
- Audiences will be directed to their seating in an orderly manner.
- Patrons are advised to arrive early and make your way to your seat as directed.
- BMEC reserves the right to move audiences to alternate seats to ensure social distancing.
