COVIDSafe Plan

For the safety of our staff, visiting artists, and the community we ask all visitors to the venue to agree to the following:

- To follow instructions from staff and volunteers.
- Respect social distancing requirements.
- Use hand sanitiser upon entry to the venue
- Ticket sales will be by phone or online only. Payments can only be made at BMEC box office if tickets are reserved by contacting Box office.
- All ticket sales will close 1 hr prior to advertised starting time. No cash will be accepted at Box Office.
- Everyone coming to BMEC will need to provide name and contact details for contact tracing purposes.
- Ticket purchasers will be required to provide name and contact details in line with standard booking process. This information will also be made available to appropriate authorities for contact tracing should a Covid-19 case arise.
- BMEC reserves the right to refuse entry to any visitor who is visibly unwell.
- We recommend the use of the COVIDSAFE app.
- Ticket holders who are feeling unwell should not attend the venue. Box office will refund tickets. Please contact them via phone prior to the event.
- Audiences will be directed to their seating in an orderly manner. Intervals will be avoided where possible.
- There will be no counter service at BMEC Bars. When appropriate we will supply table service.
- Patrons are advised to arrive early and make your way to your seat as directed.
- BMEC reserves the right to move audiences to alternate seats to ensure social distancing.

Please be patient as we introduce these new measures. They have been designed to ensure the safety of everyone in the community.
